The class will meet PROMPTLY at 9:00 a.m and will last 4 to 5 hours, or until 1:00 or 2:00 p.m. It is a rather lengthy process so I am asking people who come to arrive no later than 9:00. I did this class two summers ago and it was well-received. I will furnish many of the materials people will need, but there is a supply list which I am attaching. Please note the class is free . . . it is part of my volunteerism at the Park.

Materials List

Introduction: If you've never done paper (papier) mache', even as a kid, here's your chance! In the interest of time, we will be doing a "low relief" piece as a wall-hanging (similar to a painting or drawing). What can be accomplished in a 4-hour period is: 1) create the piece, 2) dry it with a hair dryer; 3) coat it with white wall paint or gesso or white tempera; and 4) paint the surface with a paint of your choice. ***We will begin promptly at 9:00 in order to finish the project.

A section of an old newspaper

Scissors

Masking tape

Piece of White Mat board or Corrugated Cardboard (cut to working size)

Large plastic sheet (i.e. leaf/lawn bag) on which to work

1" or larger old flat brush (any kind will do) for applying final white coat of paint

Flat Styrofoam tray or plastic plate in which to put paste

Water container

***Some kind of Paint: Colored Tempera; or Colored Inks; or Colored Acrylics; or Watercolors

HAIR DRYER plus extension cord

NOTE: Instructor will bring Wheat Flour Paste; White Tempera; and, some White Wall Paint for you to use . . . no charge, but you will need to bring your OWN CHOICE OF PAINT for the finished product (see above). Also, bring our kid-like sense of awe and your adult skills . . . we'll have fun!!!
