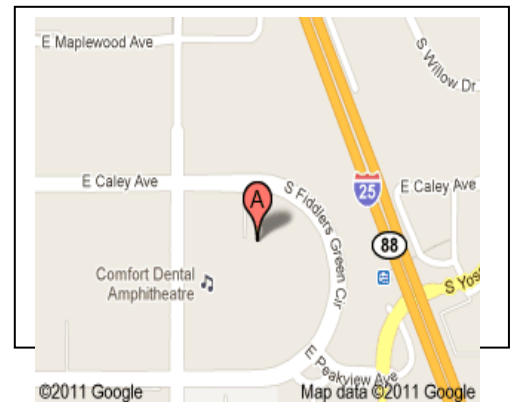
September 24 - Nancy Condit Watercolor Workshop
