Learn how to break up the complexities of the face into simple components, how to solve problems that always seem to crop up in the course of painting a face, and create a truly expressive portrait that captures the essence of the model rather than photographic detail.

Working all day from a model, Clyde will demonstrate, explain, and teach how to put the simple principles of successful portrait painting into practice—all while painting in a style that projects spontaneity and confidence.

Clyde will demonstrate in oil paints; however, the basic techniques he teaches work well for acrylic, pastel, and—with a little elbow grease—watercolor as well.

**About the Artist:**

Clyde got his start drawing people in bars and coffee shops. He quickly fell in love with art, and studied at the Art Students League of Denver. He has studied with notable artists Daniel Sprick, Quang Ho, Doug Dawson, and Mark Daily.

While he mostly uses oil paints, he has been known to show watercolors, acrylics, and pastels, and also dabbles in sculpture.
