Deb Rosenbaum - "Narrative Collage Workshop" Saturday, January 20, 2024 9am - 3pm Ascension Lutheran Church 1701 W. Caley Ave. Littleton, CO 80120

Storytelling is a basic human need like breathing. Explaining and documenting our lives, even just to ourselves, is a powerful tool for understanding and growth. In this workshop, you will learn about organizing a picture space to visually illustrate a personal experience, memory, or story in collage. Collages can become a confusing mass of images, so we'll look at how arrangement of line, shape, color, image, and movement can clearly communicate an idea. We'll create some small practice studies followed by specific story prompts as we explore ways to effectively organize a work of art.



All required materials are included, but feel free to bring any printed/patterned papers you may already have on hand, as well as personal paper ephemera. You can also bring any special art tools you like to use.
