## Workshops

### **Jennifer Ghormley - "Mixed Media Printmaking"**

**Saturday, January 21, 2023 -- 9am - 12Noon**

**First Presbyterian Church of Littleton 1609 W. Littleton Blvd.

Participants will create linoleum cut prints and combine with mixed media elements (such as watercolor, colored pencil, and/or collage). We will learn how to carve a linoleum block, ink up and print a series of images onto paper. Following, we will add mixed media elements to modify and enhance the artwork. Participants can expect to go home with a few pieces of finished artwork, as well as fresh inspiration and creative energy to continue making more artwork at home. Suggested supply list for participants to bring: • Apron or smock to protect clothes • Sketches, drawings, or ideas of what imagery they want to work with – blocks will be 4x6". • Other desired mixed media elements aside from what instructor will bring

### **Jane Shoenfeld - "Abstracting from Nature in Pastel"**

The only prerequisite is your interest in color and a personal connection to nature. Simplification of color choices in response to harmonies on the color wheel is the focus of this two-day workshop. Working with these colors will help students create vibrant pastel paintings on a variety of surfaces. The class will also look at color in terms of saturation, neutralization, and gradation of value. The focus is on both structure and concepts and loosening up.

Rather than emphasizing composition, students will discover how a specific scene is a template onto which one's interior vision is projected. In welcoming the world of the imagination – in seeing the way a child sees - participants will discover how a tree, a cloud or even a shadow is sending them a very personal invitation.

Through exercises and examples, each member of the class will look deeply, explore the interior vision hidden within the visible image, and find the mystery and personal magic in the landscape.

I will not be teaching how to “copy” what is seen, but I will offer guidance and feedback on principles that facilitate the illusion of depth or the intensity of a flattened space with intriguing figure ground relationships.

Students of all levels of experience are welcome to join the class.
