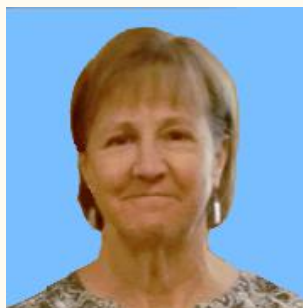
March 9, 2022, Meeting Information

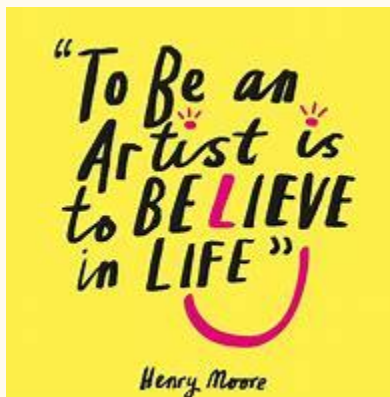
