Supply List

- Watercolor paper (140 pound or 300 pound cold press D'Arches)
- Watercolor paints (acrylics, gouache, tempera, ink, pencils, etc)
- Mixing palette or plate
- Water containers (2)
- Old brushes (watercolor, acrylic or oil, suitable for use with glue and odd additives)
- Old paintings to tear up to make new papers (old watercolor paintings are great)
- Any extra papers, tissue paper, rice paper, odds and ends, ephemera (old photos, postage stamps, maps, sheets of music, things you can tear up or reimagine, etc.)
- Elmers' Glue
- Mat board scraps (8'x10',9'x12',11'x14' or larger, if you wish) for supports for collages
- Gloss Acrylic Medium (by Golden)
- Spray bottle
- 3M Scotch Brand Clear Packing Tape 2"
- Scissors
- Paper Towels and/or Kleenex
- Sketchbook, sketches, ideas to work from
