## Materials:

- Watercolor paints
o I use paints in tubes
Brand is your option but I recommend professional grade paint
I use Winsor Newton professional grade.
o Suggested colors:
$\checkmark$ French Ultramarine Blue
$\checkmark$ Cobalt Blue
$\checkmark$ Cerulean Blue
$\checkmark$ Red-Permanent Rose or Permanent Alizarin Crimson
$\checkmark$ Yellow - New Gamboge
$\checkmark$ Green - Sap green or Viridian Green or Hookers
$\checkmark$ Brown - Burnt Sienna
$\checkmark$ Violet-Winsor Violet
- Watercolor Palette
- Watercolor Paper - approximately $9 \times 12$-several sheets or $11 \times 14$ Paper comes in pads, already cut to size OR can be purchased in full size single sheets, $22 \times 30$, and then you cut it into quarters. Arches is a good brand.
- Watercolor Brushes
o 1 large wash brush
o 1 round \#12 min size
o 1 flat
o 1 pointed or small round
Make sure they are Watercolor brushes, not oil or acrylic.
- Backing - masonite or foam core boards -larger than your paper size so we can tape it down
- Masking tape (not blue painters' tape)
- Water cups
- Pencil and kneaded eraser
- Paper towels/tissue
